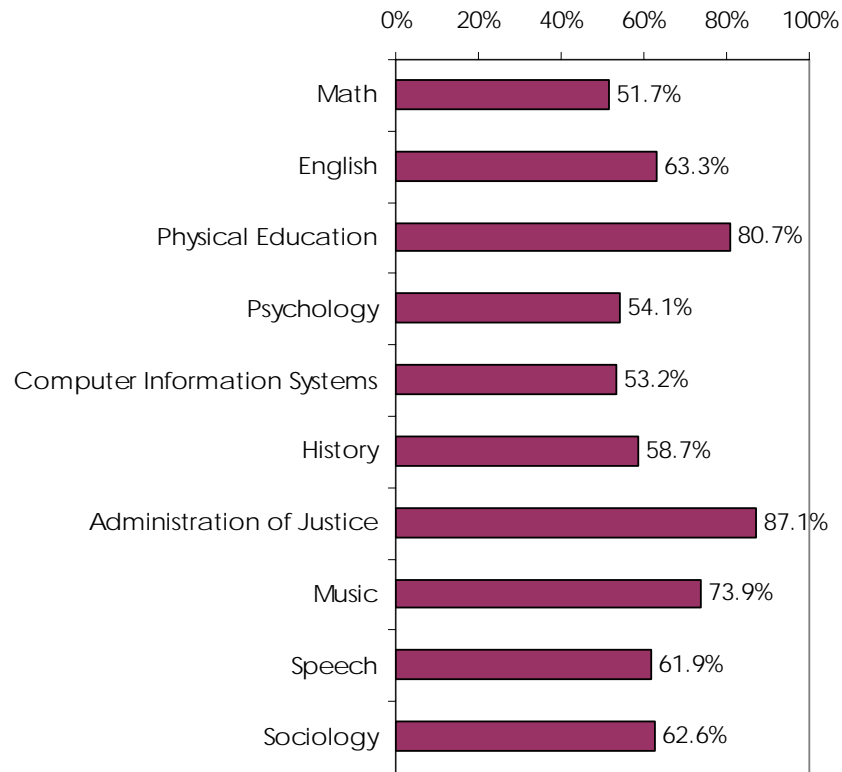

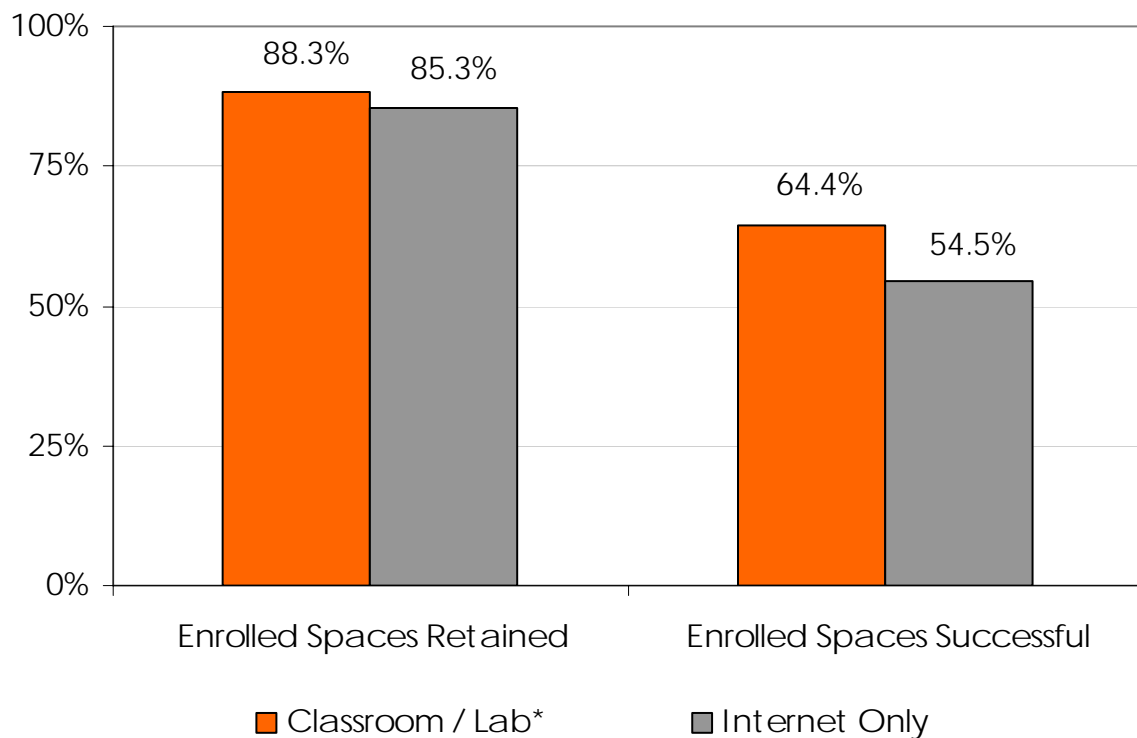

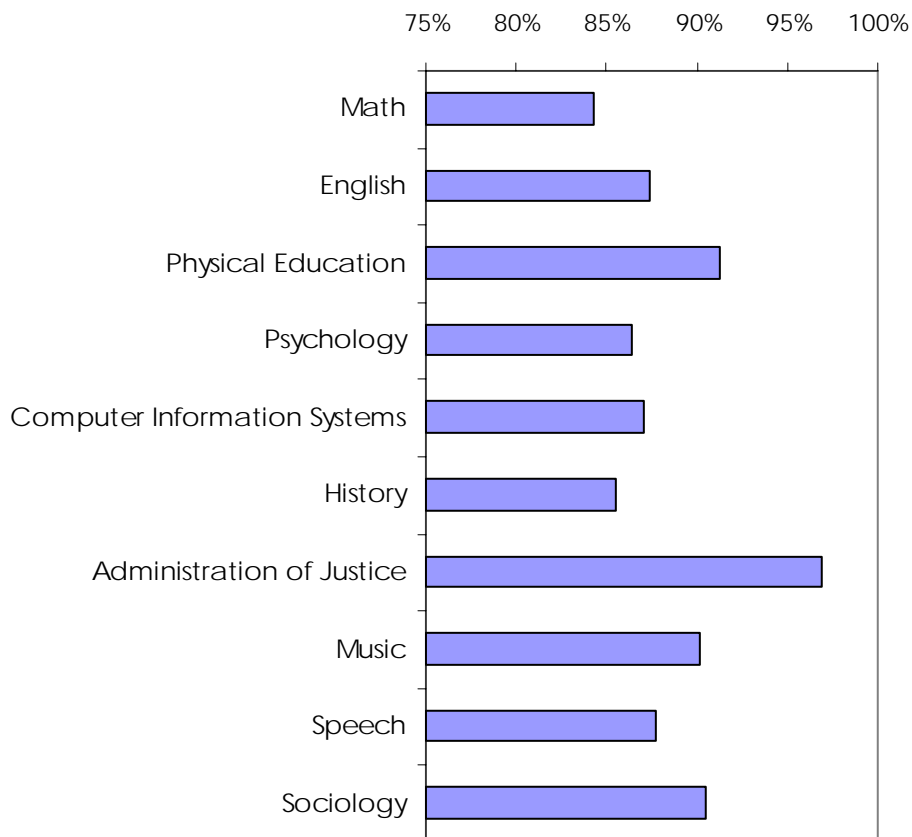

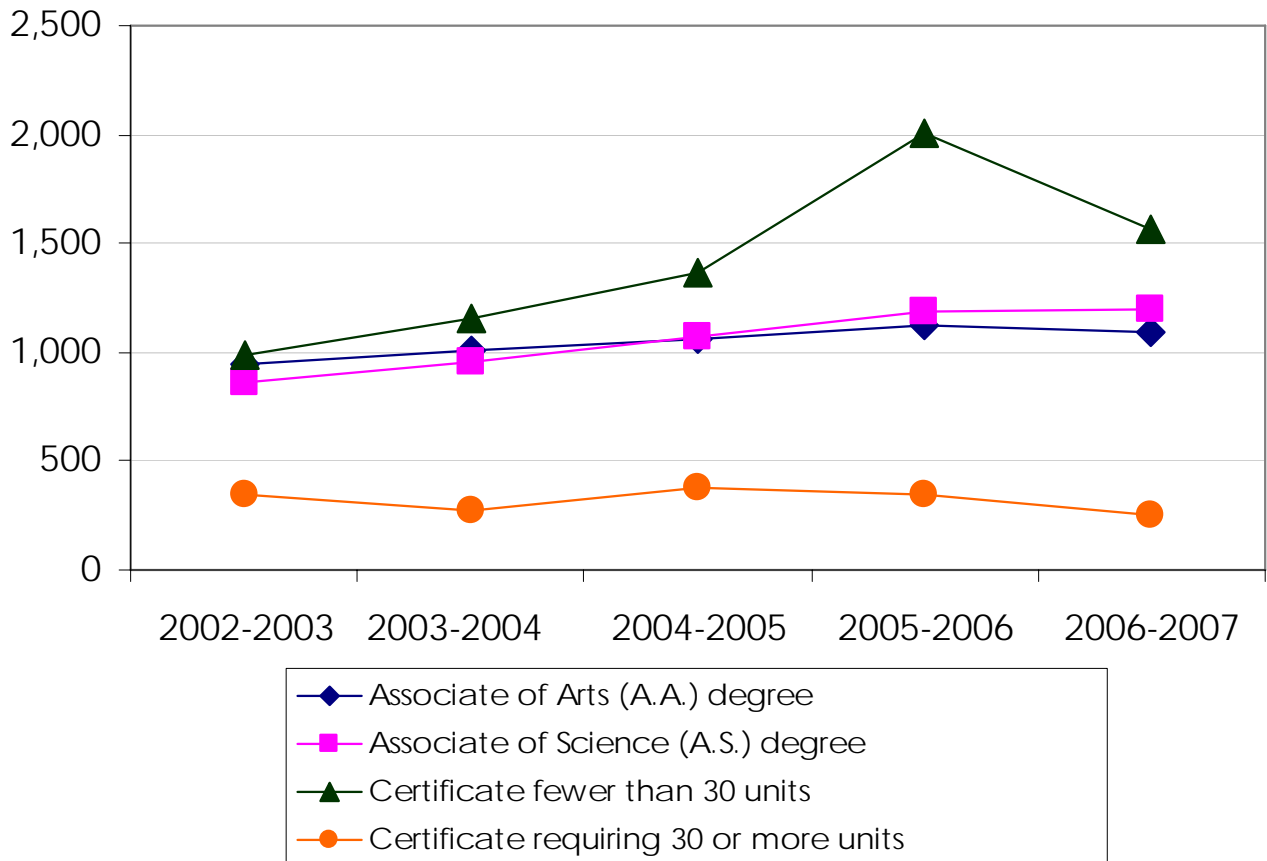

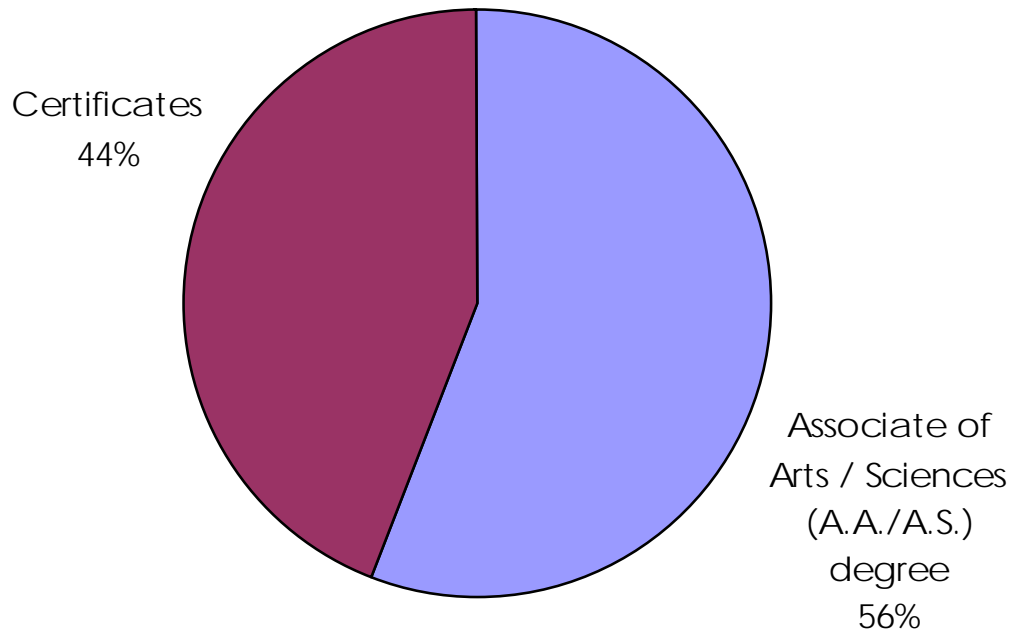

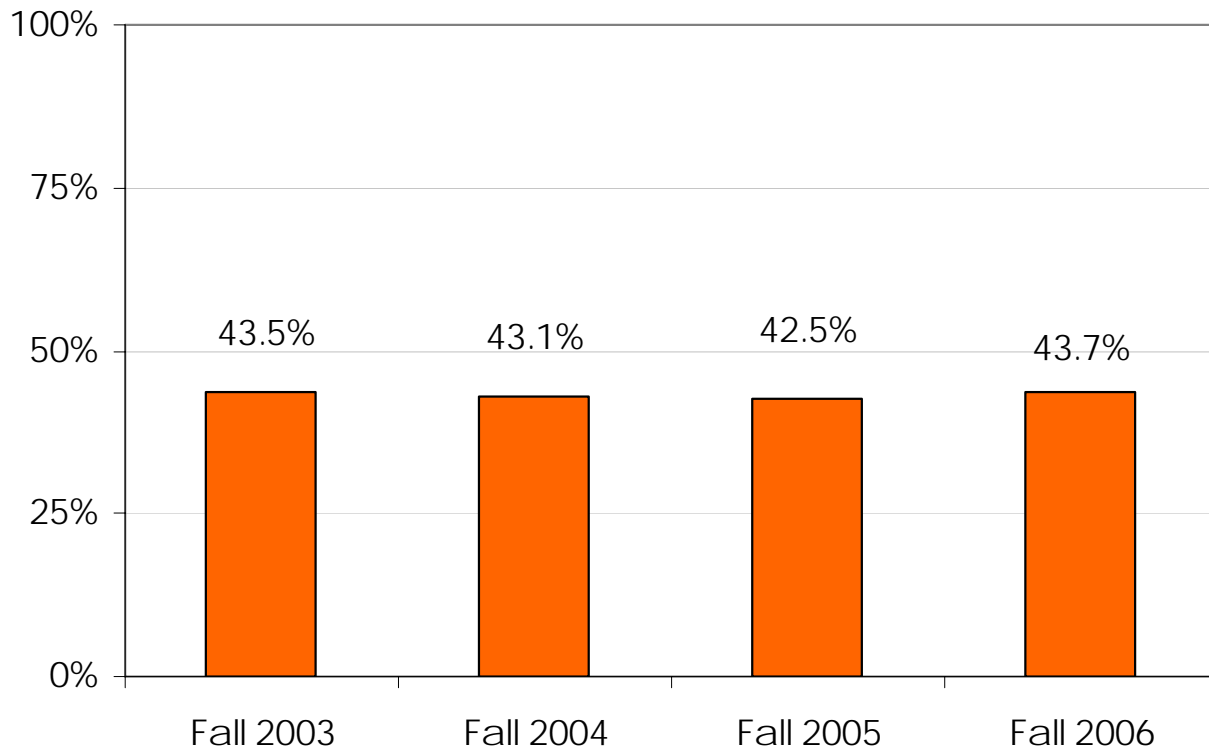

 2003 through 2006**



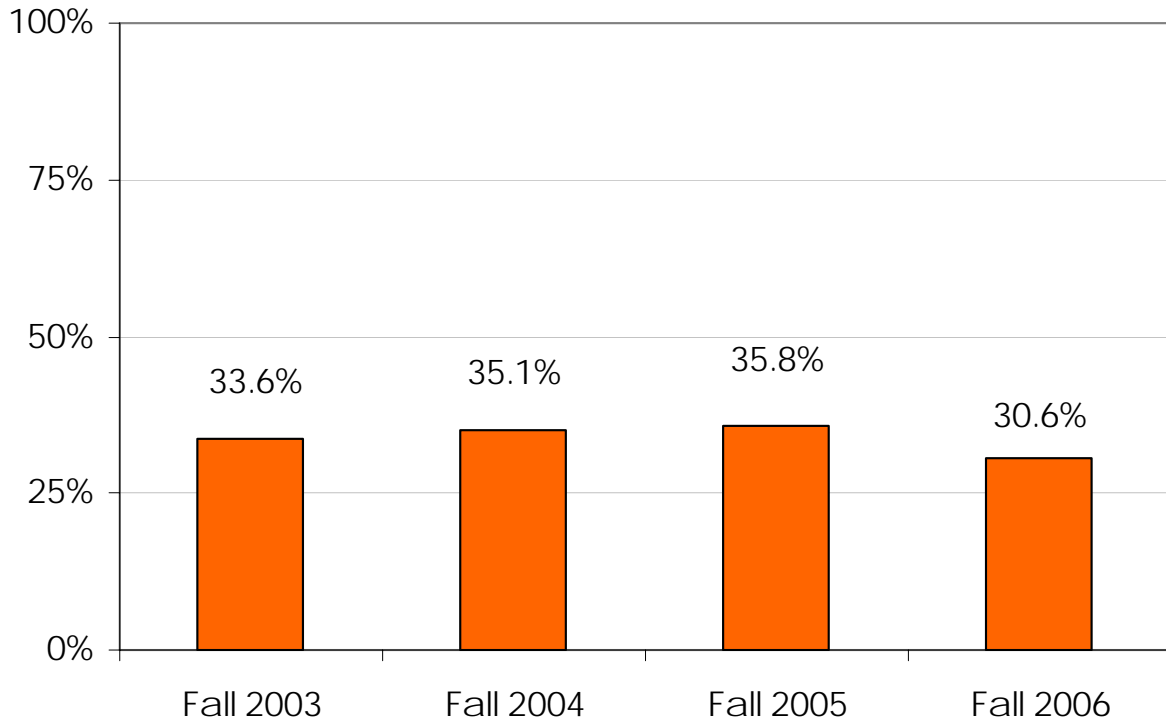

2003 through 2006**



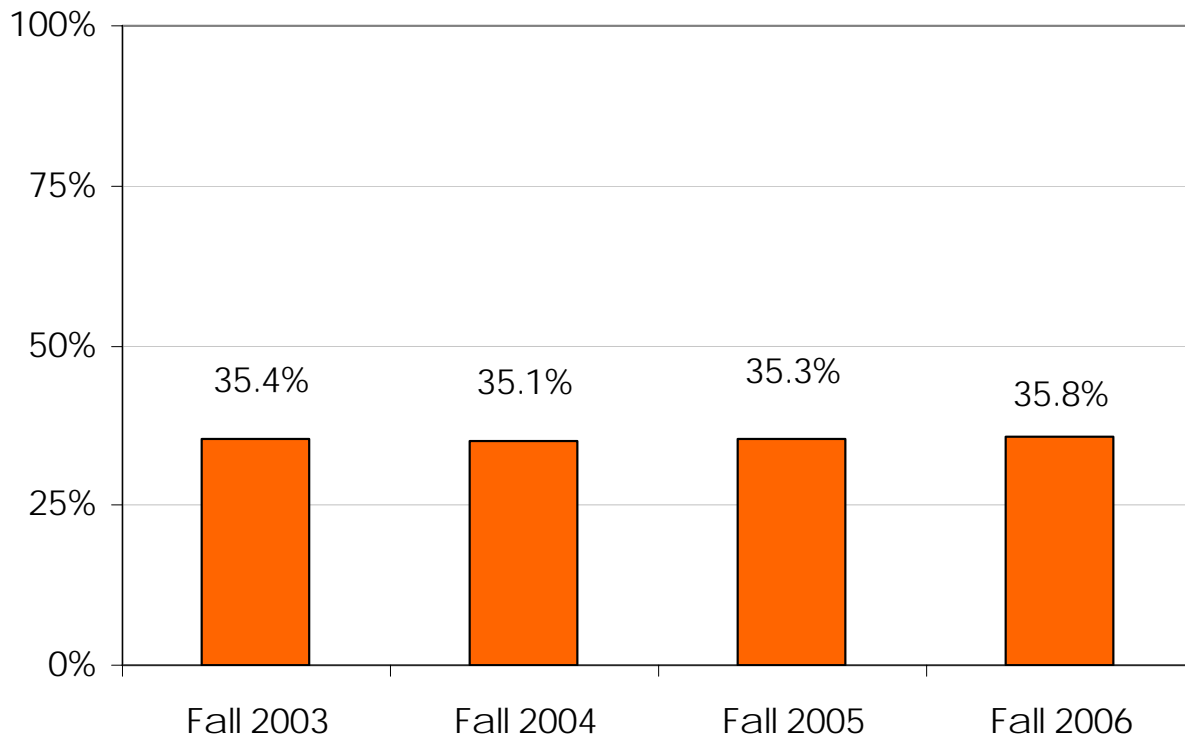

2003 through 2006



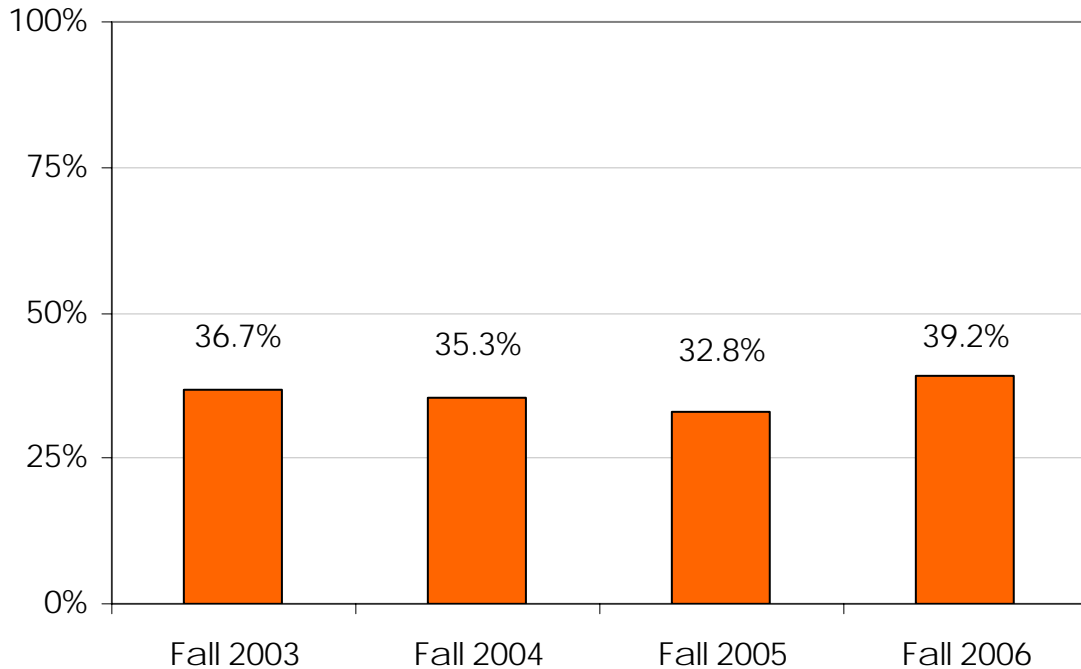

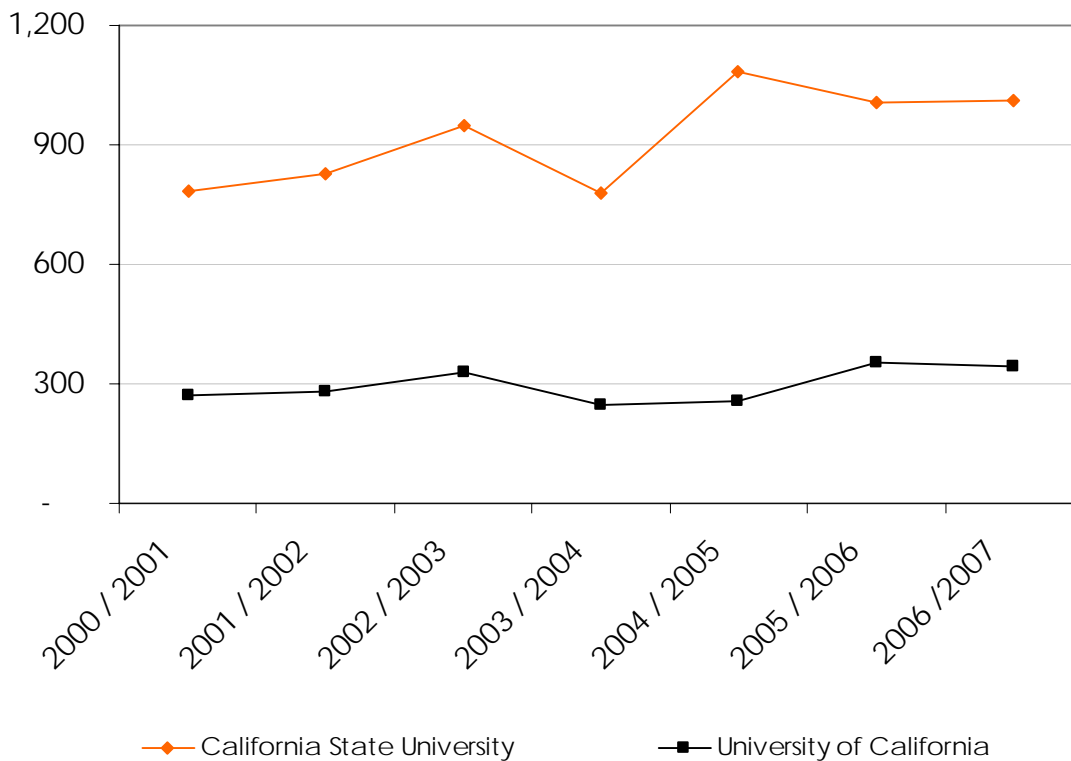

Beginning in Fall 2003, a cohort of all certificate-, degree-, and transfer-seeking first-time, full-time students were tracked over a three-year period. Their completion and transfer rates are listed above.

Based upon the cohort defined above, a **Completer** is a student who

- attained a certificate or degree or
- became 'transfer prepared*',
- during a three year period from Fall 2003 to Spring 2006.

Students are "**transfer students**" if they

- transferred to another post-secondary institution, prior to attaining a degree, certificate, or becoming 'transfer-prepared*',
- during a five semester period from Spring 2004 to Spring 2004.

These rates do not represent the success rates of the entire student population at the College nor do they account for student outcomes occurring after this three-year tracking period.

*Students are considered '**transfer-prepared**' if they completed 56 transferable units with a grade point average of 2.0 or better.
